

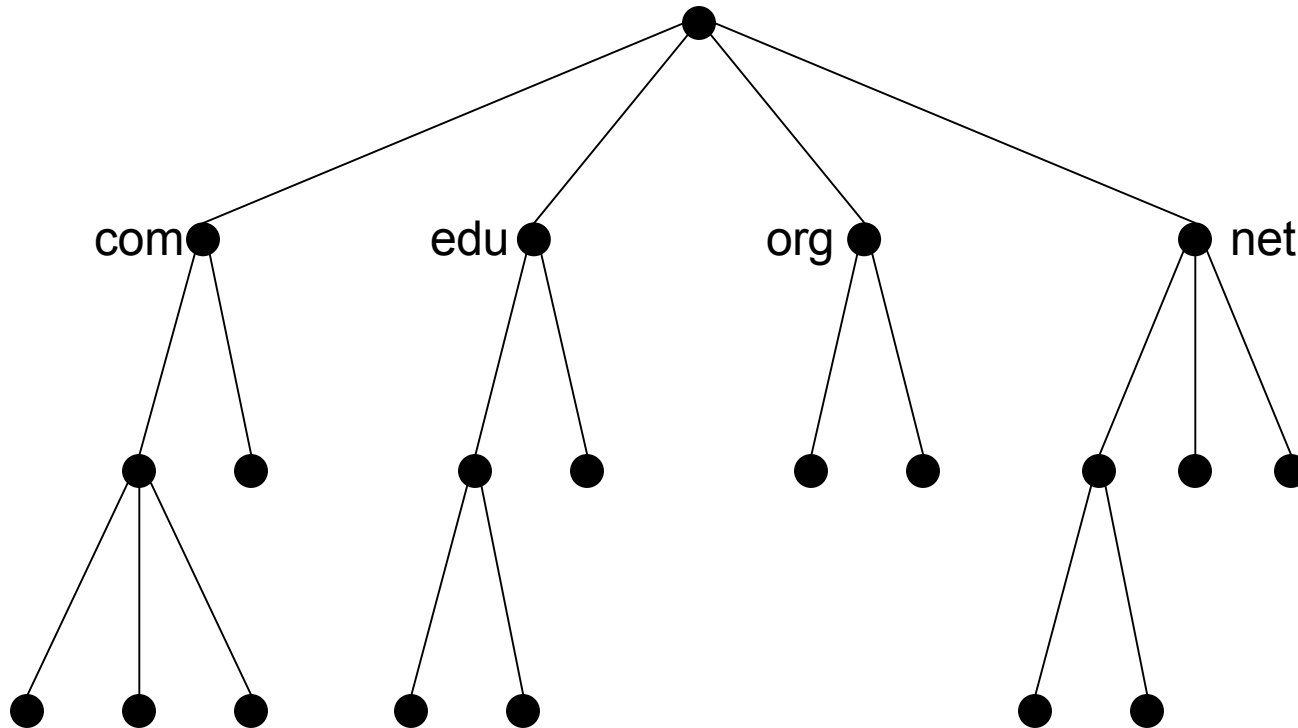

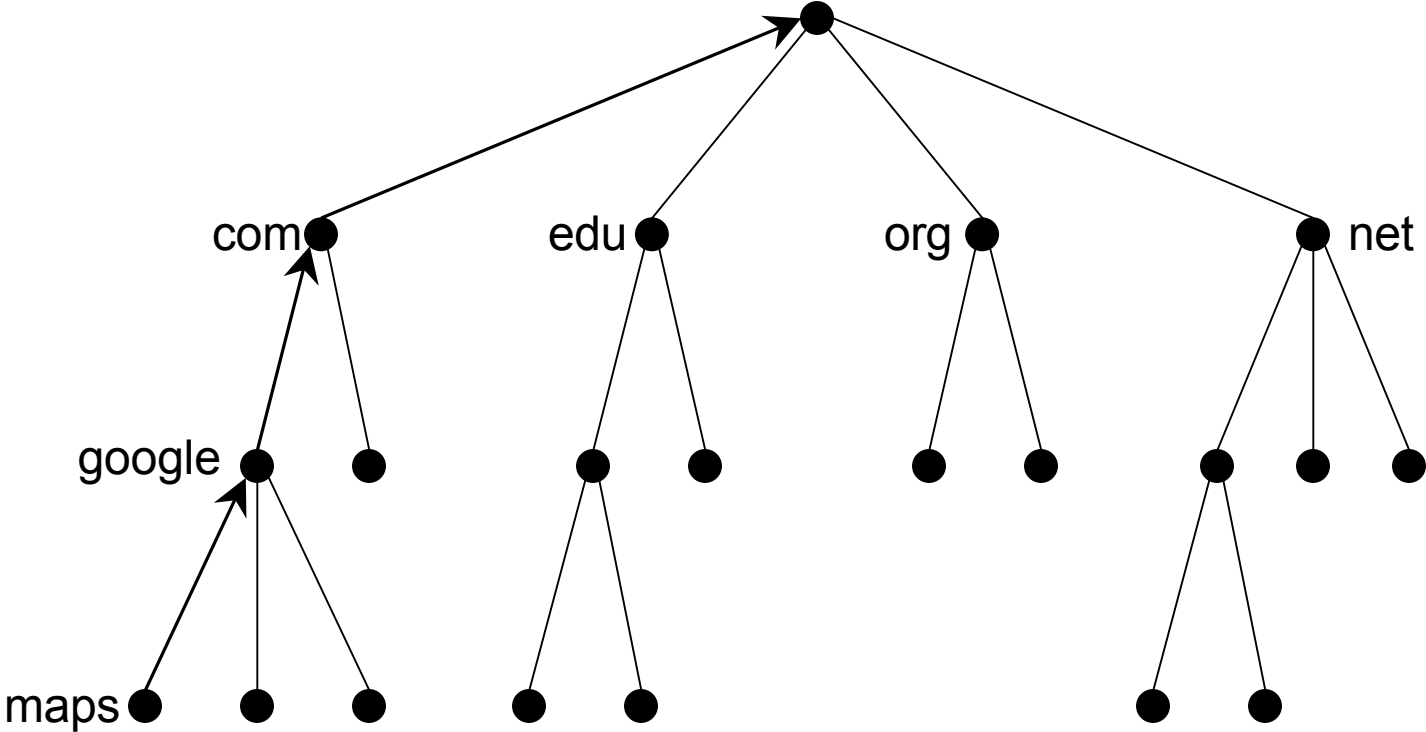
Domain Name System

- Translates hostnames to IP addresses
- Translates IP addresses to hostnames
- Hierarchical distributed database
- Local administration of your portion
- Structure similar to UNIX file system

DNS Structure



Domain Names are bottom-up



maps.google.com.

Relative and Absolute

- Domain names can be relative or absolute:
maps or *maps.google.com*.
- Trailing dot always marks absolute name
- Also called Fully Qualified Domain Name, or FQDN
- Relative names may have default domain appended

Domain Name Data

- Domain name is “key” to DNS data
- Name points to host information: address, mail server, etc.
- Name can also be alias for another name.

Resource Records

Each node contains resource records

A	addresses
MX	mail exchanger
NS	name server
CNAME	symbolic link
PTR	hostname
SRV	service information

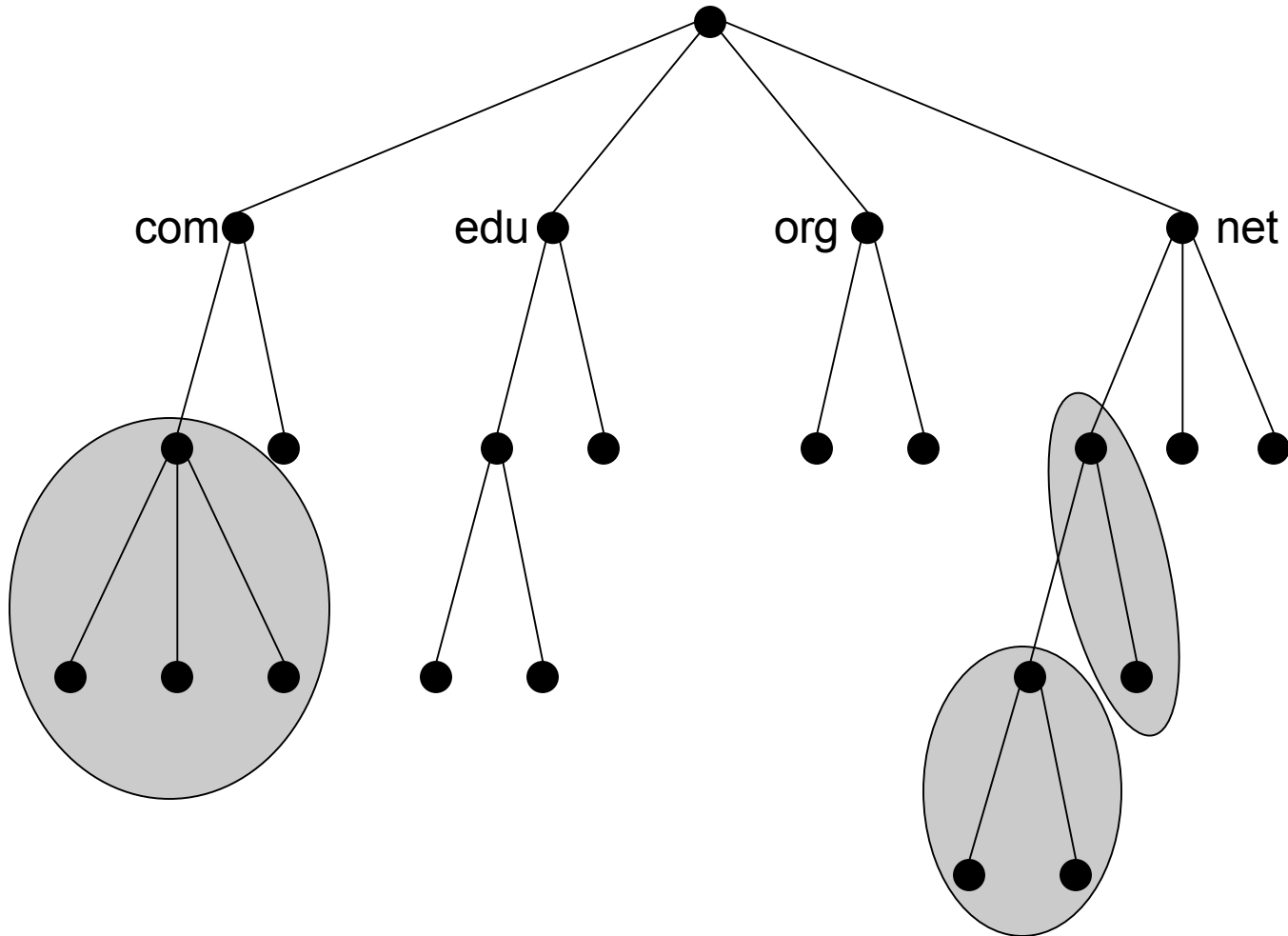
Resource Records

host.domain.com.	A	10.2.4.8
ftp.domain.com.	CNAME	host
domain.com.	MX 0	host
www.domain.com.	A	10.2.5.1
www.domain.com.	A	10.2.5.2

Zones

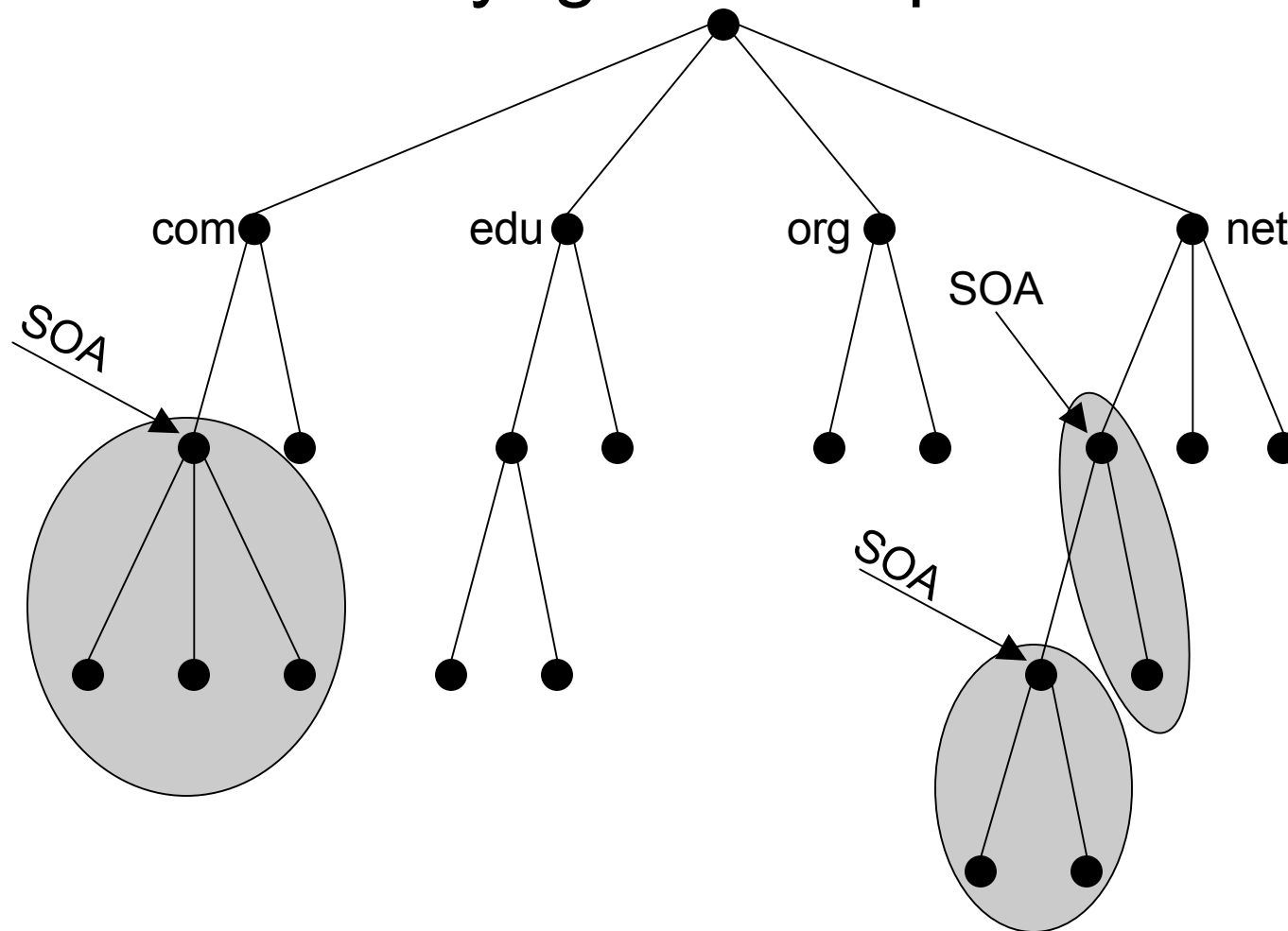
- Name space split in to zones
- Consists of adjacent nodes
- Zones administered separately
- All information for zone kept together

Zones



SOA Record

Start of Authority: goes at top of zone



Administering a Zone

- Must set up a server
- Must create resource records for zone
- Must give server addresses to parent
- Set up “reverse zone”

Reverse Zones

- Reverse zone maps IP addresses to names
- Domain in-addr.arpa reserved for names that encode addresses
- 10.2.4.8 encoded as 8.4.2.10.in-addr.arpa
- Data contains PTR record with hostname
- Must be maintained in parallel with host domain
