OVERVIEW: The Third International Conference on Mobile Systems, Applications, and Services (MobiSys 2005) will be held June 6–8, 2005, in Seattle, Washington. This is a premier venue for researchers working in the area of mobile and wireless systems, middleware, services, and applications. The previous two conferences, in San Francisco and Boston, were quite successful, with strong refereed paper presentations, demonstrations, poster sessions, and workshops.

WHAT TO SUBMIT: We solicit workshop proposals on new and emerging topics in the general area of mobile and wireless systems, services, and applications. The ideal proposal should focus on a specific area, be of current interest, and be able to attract a number of high-quality submissions. The proposal should be no longer than a few pages and should clearly identify the theme of the workshop, specify topic areas of interest to define the scope, and suggest potential program chairs and program committee members.
