So Why Are These Questions Bad?

So Why Are These Questions Bad?

- They ask about trivia
- But you care about knowledge
- And understanding
- Not to mention trouble-shooting skills

What to Ask Instead

What to Ask Instead

- "What command lists the contents of a directory?"
 - "Lots of output options; what are some of them?"
 - "Can you change the sort order?"
 - "On which keys?"
- Which leads to . . .

Filesystem Questions

- "What / how many 'times' are stored about a file?"
 - atime, ctime, mtime
- "What do they mean?"
- And this leads to . . .

Inodes

- "What is an inode?"
- "What's stored in the inode?"
- "Is the file name stored in the inode?"
 - "If not, where is it stored?"
- Which brings us to . . .

Links

- "What's the difference between a hard link and a symbolic link?"
- "Can you make a hard link to a directory?"
- "Can hard links cross filesystems?"
 - "If not, why not?"

See the Difference?

- Trivia questions test, well, trivia
 - And don't go anywhere
- Good technical questions probe both the depth and breadth of a candidate's knowledge and understanding
 - There are those words again
