NSDI

One of the best paper awards had a co-chair as an author. It was missed in the best paper selection because Chairs were not involved in the selection. Chairs weren't even consulted; there was a separate selection committee. It was an issue of perception, not about actual ethical violations. The NSDI steering committee has declared going forward that no program chair-submitted paper can be considered for an award. Noble and Henderson propose the adoption of a similar, expanded structure for all conferences.

Code of Ethics and ACM

Discussed previously whether USENIX needed a code of ethics for steering committees, etc. The NSDI program co-chairs want to cite a code of ethics. We are in-cooperation with ACM for this event. Their current CFP cites the ACM code of ethics. We have always given chairs extraordinary latitude with respect to content in CFPs so this fits.

Annual Meeting

Will probably move the annual BOD meeting to different conferences; this year it will take place at the Security Symposium. We did not have the summer BOD meeting at ATC because it is not an election year.
